*West Glamorgan County Council (King's Lane, Swansea)
(Weight Restriction) Order 1975*

Notice is hereby given that the West Glamorgan County Council in exercise of their powers under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968 and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act, 1972 propose to make an Order the effect of which will prohibit all vehicles which exceed 3 tons unladen weight from proceeding in King's Lane, Swansea from between its junctions with the Strand and High Street.

A copy of the proposed Order and a map showing the length of road to which it relates may be inspected at the offices of the West Glamorgan County Council, Room 215, The Guildhall, Swansea during normal office hours.

*West Glamorgan County Council (Main Road, Llangennith)
(Revocation and Limited Waiting) Order, 1975*

Notice is hereby given that the West Glamorgan County Council propose to make an Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968, and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972, the effect of which will be to revoke any Order made by the former Glamorgan County Council in respect of the side of the road specified in the Schedule below and will prohibit vehicles from waiting, on the same side for a longer period than 30 minutes in any hour, between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on any day other than a Sunday from 1st May to 30th September, in any year.

The Order will provide for the usual exceptions for the purposes of boarding, alighting, loading and unloading etc., and will also exempt disabled drivers therefrom.

A copy of the proposed Order and a map showing the sides of the road to which it relates may be inspected during normal office hours at Room 215, County Clerk's Department, The Guildhall, Swansea.

Objections to the proposals together with the grounds on which they are made must be sent in writing to the undersigned by the 19th July 1975.

West Glamorgan County Council (Pentre Road, Waungron-Route B4296) (30 m.p.h. Speed Restriction) Order, 1975

Notice is hereby given that the West Glamorgan County Council propose to make an Order under sections 72 (3) and 73 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968, and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act, 1972, the effect of which will be to restrict traffic to a maximum speed of 30 m.p.h. on that length of Pentre Road, Waungron, Route B4296, to include the derestricted length of road from the commencement of the existing 30 m.p.h. restricted zone south of the junctions of Park Terrace, Pontardulais, a total of 1.3 miles approximately. This will cover the whole length of road from Gravesend to Pontardulais with a 30 m.p.h. restriction.

A copy of the proposed Order and a map showing the road to which it relates, together with a statement of reasons for the making of the Order may be inspected during normal office hours at Room 215, County Clerk's Department, The Guildhall, Swansea and at Lliw Valley Council Offices, West Street, Gorseinon.

GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

Gloucestershire County Council (Cirencester) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order, 1975

Notice is hereby given that on 20th June 1975 the Gloucestershire County Council made an Order under sections 1 and 84D (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968, and Schedule 19 of the Local Government Act, 1972, the effects of which are:

1. To vary the Gloucestershire County Council (Various Roads, Cirencester) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1967, and the Gloucestershire County Council (Various Roads, Cirencester) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) (Variation) Order, 1970, so as to remove the prohibition and restriction on waiting on Gosditch Street and West Market Place and to substitute the restrictions specified below.

2. To vary the Gloucestershire County Council (Cirencester) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order, 1973, by the removal of the prohibition of waiting between 8 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Castle Street (A.429) from its junction with Silver Street (A.429) for a distance of 32 metres in a south-westerly direction and to substitute the restriction specified below.

3. To prohibit the waiting of vehicles in the road, in any of the lengths of road or on the side of the length of road specified in Schedule I to this notice.

4. To prohibit the waiting of vehicles between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. in any of the lengths of road specified in Schedule II to this notice.

The restriction contained in paragraph 4 above shall not apply to invalid carriages and certain other vehicles used by disabled drivers subject to a proviso (to allow for traffic conditions in special circumstances) that the vehicle is moved immediately upon the direction of a police constable in uniform or a traffic warden in uniform.

5. To prohibit the waiting of vehicles between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on

A. the north-western side of Querns Lane, Cirencester, from a point 43 metres north-east of its junction with Sheep Street and Querns Hill to a point 59 metres north-east of that point;

B. the south-eastern side of Querns Lane, Cirencester, from a point 43 metres north-east of its junction with Sheep Street and Querns Hill to a point 17 metres north-east of that point.

A disabled person's vehicle may wait for a maximum period of 2 hours on either of the sides of lengths of road specified in paragraph 5. above.

Exceptions to the restrictions in paragraphs 3, 4 and 5 above permit waiting for the purposes of:

- (a) picking up and setting down passengers;
- (b) loading and unloading goods;
- (c) the delivery or collection of mail by a vehicle in the service of or employed by the Post Office;
- (d) building operations, maintenance of the road or the services therein;
- (e) in pursuance of statutory powers or duties.

A copy of the Order which comes into operation on 27th June 1975, together with the relevant map, may be inspected during all reasonable hours at the Shire Hall, Gloucester, and at the Cotswold District Council Offices, 5 Dyer Street, Cirencester.

Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the ground that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968, and the Local Government Act, 1972, or on the ground that any requirement of that Act or any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may, within 6 weeks of the date on which the Order is made, apply to the High Court for this purpose.
