The County Council of Salop (Wesley Brook Bridge, Shifnal) (Prohibition of Driving) Order

SALOP COUNTY COUNCIL

The County Council of Salop (St. Mary Street, Newport) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1975

Notice is hereby given that on the 26th June 1975, the Salop County Council made an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended.

When the Order comes into effect on the 30th June 1975, it will perpetuate the current experimental Order, which amended the prohibited and restricted waiting and introduced new restrictions in lengths of St. Mary Street, Newport.

The exemptions in the experimental Order will continue to apply.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provisions contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made

under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within 6 weeks from the 26th June 1975, apply for the purpose to the High Court.

SEDGEMOOR DISTRICT COUNCIL

The Sedgemoor District Council (Wembdon Road, Bridgwater) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) (No. 6) Order, 1975.

Notice is hereby given that on the 18th June 1975 the District Council of Sedgemoor, pursuant to arrangements made under section 101 of the Local Government Act, 1972 with the County Council of Somerset in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) and section 84D of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act, 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act, 1974 and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with section 84C (i) of the Act of 1967 made an Order the effect of which is to prohibit waiting at any time in Wembdon Road, from the Quantock Gate junction (Wembdon Road/Quantock Road) eastwards to the junction with North Street.

The Order will come into operation on the 23rd June 1975.

A copy of the Order, together with a map showing the length of road to which it relates, may be inspected at the office of the District Secretary and Chief Legal Adviser, Sedgemoor District Council, The Priory, St. Mary Street, Bridgwater during normal office hours.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the power conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968, and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act, 1972, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within 6 weeks from the date of the making of the Order apply to the High Court for this purpose.

SOMERSET COUNTY COUNCIL

Somerset (City of Wells) (Doctor Parking Places) (No. 1) Order 1975

Notice is hereby given that the Somerset County Council propose to make an Order under sections 35, 36 and 37 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972, and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974.
