

"Come to my Bedside" imported into the United Kingdom and found at Heathrow Airport, London, on or about the 2nd May 1975, AW13 117-35496215 refers, have been seized as liable to forfeiture upon the grounds that the said goods are indecent or obscene articles which were imported contrary to the prohibition contained in section 42 of the Customs Consolidation Act 1876, and further that if any of the said articles is not in itself indecent, it was mixed, packed or found with an indecent article, liable to forfeiture under Customs Acts.
