*The Trunk Roads (Salutation Square, Haverfordwest)
(Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1975*

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for Wales, intends to make an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, the effect of which will be to prohibit waiting in the length of road or on any of the sides of the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this notice.

Exceptions will be provided in the Order to enable a vehicle to wait for so long as may be necessary for a person to board or alight from the vehicles; to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle; to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance of the road or the services therein; or to enable the vehicle to be used in the service of a local authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties.

Exceptions will also be provided in the Order to allow vehicles bearing both a disabled persons badge and a disabled persons parking disc to wait in the length of road or on any of the sides of lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this notice for a period of 2 hours (not being a period separated by an interval of less than 1 hour from a previous period of waiting, if any, by the same vehicle in the same length of road or on the same side of length of road, as the case may be, on the same day).

A copy of the proposed Order, together with a plan and a statement of reasons for making the Order, may be seen during normal office hours at the offices of the Preseli District Council, Cambria House, Haverfordwest.

Objections to the proposed Order should be sent to the Secretary of State, Welsh Office, Roads Department (Y Swyddfa Gymreig, Adran Ffyrdd), 139 Newport Road, Cardiff, CF2 1YU, quoting the reference number WR 15/2/19, not later than 15th August 1975 stating the grounds for objection.

SCHEDULE

Sides of lengths of the Haverfordwest—Milford Haven Trunk Road (A.4076) (hereinafter in this Schedule referred to as "the first trunk road") at Haverfordwest in the County of Dyfed:

- (1) that length of the northern side of the first trunk road, known as Picton Place, which extends from its junction with New Bridge in a general north-easterly direction to its junction with Salutation Square;
- (2) that length of the southern side of the first trunk road, known as Picton Place, which extends from its junction with New Bridge in a general north-easterly direction to its junction with Salutation Square.

Lengths and sides of lengths of the London—Fishguard Trunk Road (A.40) (hereinafter in this Schedule referred to as "the second trunk road") at Haverfordwest in the County of Dyfed:

- (3) the western side of the second trunk road forming that part of the western side of Salutation Square roundabout which extends from its junction with Picton Place in a general southerly direction to its junction with Lower Marsh Road;
- (4) the southern side of the second trunk road forming that part of the southern side of Salutation Square roundabout which extends from its junction with Lower Marsh Road in a general easterly direction to its junction with Cambrian Place;

(5) the southern side of the second trunk road forming that part of the southern side of Salutation Square roundabout which extends from its junction with Cambrian Place in a general easterly direction to its junction with Cartlett.

(6) that length of the second trunk road known as Cartlett which extends from its junction with Salutation Square in a general easterly direction to a point 284 yards south-east of its junction with Mill Road, a distance of 214 yards.

*Offshore Petroleum Development (Scotland) Act 1975
Designated Sea Area—Loch Fyne*

The Secretary of State hereby gives notice, that in terms of section 3 of and Schedule 3 to the Offshore Petroleum Development (Scotland) Act 1975 he has decided to make a sea designation Order providing for the making of a Designated Sea Area in a part of Loch Fyne in the area of Tarbert described by two lines running across the loch some 3½ miles apart from the west shore to the east shore. The more northerly line runs due east from a point approximately ½ mile north of Barmore Island (NR 864 724) and the more southerly from a point approximately ½ mile south of Eilean a Chomhraig (Battle Island) (NR 888 672). The area within the limits of the Tarbert (Loch Fyne) Harbour Trustees will be excluded.

The purpose of the designation is to enable the Secretary of State to facilitate or control the execution of operations relating to the exploration for and exploitation of offshore petroleum.
