Different rates of interest apply according to whether the principal of a loan is repaid by instalments or at maturity.

## TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971

The Secretary of State for Wales hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order under section 209 of the above Act to authorise the diversion of the length of highway described in Schedule 1 to this notice and the stopping up of the length of highway described in Schedule 2 to this notice to enable development to be carried out by the National Coal Board.

The proposed Order will require that the new length of highway to be provided as the diversion is to be a highway maintainable by the National Coal Board for the first year and thereafter at the public expense and for which the highway authority will be the Dyfed County Council. The proposed Order will also require the provision of a further length of new highway maintainable as aforesaid for which the said Council will be the highway authority.

During 28 days from 1st August 1975 copies of the draft Order and relevant plan may be inspected at all reasonable hours at the offices of the Dinefwr Borough Council, Council Offices, Crescent Road, Llandeilo, Dyfed, and may be obtained free of charge from the Secretary of

State (quoting reference WR15/2/21) at the address stated below.

Within the above mentioned period of 28 days, any person may, by notice to the Secretary of State, Welsh Office, Roads Department (Y Swyddfa Gymreig, Adran Ffrydd), Graham Buildings, 139 Newport Road, Cardiff, CF2 1YU (quoting the reference WR15/2/21), object to the making of the Order, stating the grounds for objection.

## SCHEDULE 1

*Length of Highway to be Diverted*  
(all distances are approximate)

The length of highway to be diverted is at Llandybie in the Borough of Dinefwr in the County of Dyfed and is that length of the Llandybie—Gorslas Road (B4556) which extends from a point 323 yards south-west of its junction with Woodfield Avenue in a general south-westerly direction for a distance of 1,350 yards.

## SCHEDULE 2

*Length of Highway to be Stopped up*  
(all distances are approximate)

The length of highway to be stopped up is at Llandybie in the Borough of Dinefwr in the County of Dyfed and is that length of unclassified road which extends from a point 73 yards north-east of Nant-y-Wrâch Gate in a general north-easterly direction for a distance of 333 yards, to its junction with the Llandybie to Gorslas Road (B4556).

## ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1967

*The Trunk Road (Various Streets, Caernarvon)*  
(One-Way Traffic) Order 1975

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for Wales has made an Order in connection with the Caernarvon Inner Relief Road, under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, which shall come into operation on 4th August 1975. The effect of the Order is to prohibit any person from causing any vehicle from proceeding in the lengths of road specified in Column 1 of the Schedule to this notice in a direction other than that specified in relation to that length of road in Column 2 of the said Schedule.

A copy of the Order, together with a plan and a statement of reasons for making the Order, may be seen during normal office hours at the offices of the Gwynedd County Council, Highways and Transportation Department, Maesinla, Caernarvon, during a period of six weeks from 18th July 1975.
