## BLACKPOOL BOROUGH COUNCIL

*The Borough of Blackpool (East Park Drive)  
(Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1975*

Notice is hereby given that Blackpool Borough Council pursuant to arrangements made under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with the Lancashire County Council in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and Schedule 19 of the Local Government Act 1972, propose to make a Road Traffic Order to prohibit waiting at any time on the west side of that length of East Park Drive adjacent to the golf course being a length of approximately 120 metres from Stanley Park entrance to the slip road leading from East Park Drive to North Park Drive.

Exceptions will permit vehicles to wait when engaged in building operations or the repair of the road or the services therein.

A copy of the draft Order, a relevant plan and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order may be examined at the Town Clerk's Office, Town Hall, Blackpool, during normal office hours.

## BLACKPOOL BOROUGH COUNCIL

*The Borough of Blackpool (Handsworth Road/Sherbourne Road)  
(Experimental Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1975*

Notice is hereby given that Blackpool Borough Council pursuant to arrangements made under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with the Lancashire County Council in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under section 9 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and Schedule 19 of the Local Government Act 1972, propose to make a Road Traffic Order to prohibit waiting at any time on the following lengths of road:

- (a) *Handsworth Road*, south side from Cromwell Road to Grantham Road.

- (b) *Handsworth Road*, both sides for a distance of 14 metres east of Sherbourne Road.

- (c) *Sherbourne Road*, east side for a distance of 9 metres north and south of Handsworth Road.

Exceptions will permit waiting for the purpose of picking up and setting down passengers, loading or unloading goods, and where necessary, in connection with the repair of the road or the services therein.

A copy of the draft Order, a relevant plan and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order may be examined at the Town Clerk's Office, Town Hall, Blackpool, during normal office hours.

## BLACKPOOL BOROUGH COUNCIL

*The Borough of Blackpool (Autumn Illuminations)  
Restriction on Movement of Traffic Order 1975*

Notice is hereby given that on the 31st July 1975 the Blackpool Borough Council pursuant to arrangements made under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with the Lancashire County Council made an Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, the effect of which will be to regulate the flow of traffic on the Promenade on Saturdays and Sundays during the period of the Autumn Illuminations (5th September to 26th October inclusive).

A copy of the Order and of the relevant map may be inspected during normal office hours at the Town Hall, Blackpool.

Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or any provisions contained in the Order on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the relevant section of the Act or on the grounds that any requirement of those sections has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may within 6 weeks of the date on which the Order was made make application for the purpose to the High Court.

## BUCKINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

*The Buckinghamshire County Council (A.412 North Orbital Road, Denham) (Traffic Regulation) Order, 1975*

Notice is hereby given that Buckinghamshire County Council propose to make an Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act, 1972, and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act, 1974, the effect of which will be:

- (1) To prohibit vehicles other than those being used for agricultural purposes as defined in section 293 of the Town and Country Planning Act, 1971, from entering or leaving the western side of the A.412 North Orbital Road, Denham, including the length of redundant road now forming part of the road verge between a point 350 metres north of its junction with Green Tiles Lane to a point 450 metres north of that junction.
- (2) To prohibit vehicles from waiting in that length of the A.412 North Orbital Road, Denham, including the lay-by and the verges adjacent to the road from a point 10 metres south of its junction with Green Tiles Lane to a point 990 metres north of that junction.

Exemptions will be provided in the Order to enable a vehicle to wait upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable or of a traffic warden in uniform, to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, or the maintenance of the road or the services therein and the use of the road in pursuance of statutory powers or duties including police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes.

A copy of the proposed Order and a map indicating the lengths of road affected, together with a statement of the reasons for proposing to make the Order may be inspected during normal office hours at County Hall, Aylesbury and at the offices of the Beaconsfield District Council, Council
