*The County Council of South Glamorgan
(Hawthorn Road East/Station Road, Cardiff)
(Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1975*

Notice is hereby given that the County Council of South Glamorgan in exercise of its powers under Section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by the Transport Act 1968, the Local Government Act 1972 and the Road Traffic Act 1974 proposes making an Order the general effect of which will be to prevent you from leaving your vehicle

- (i) at any time on both sides of Hawthorn Road East for a distance of 10 metres east of the junction with Station Road.
- (ii) at any time on the east side of Station Road for a distance of 10 metres north and 10 metres south of the junction with Hawthorn Road East.
- (iii) between the hours of 8 a.m. and 5 p.m., Monday to Friday on the north-west side of Hawthorn Road East, from the junction with Hawthorn Lane North for a distance of 70 metres north-east.

Exemptions will be permitted for the following reasons:

- (a) boarding or alighting from a vehicle;
- (b) loading and unloading of goods;
- (c) essential services and funerals;
- (d) for a maximum period of two hours vehicles being used for the conveyance of disabled persons when displaying an orange badge.

SOUTH GLAMORGAN COUNTY COUNCIL

*The County Council of South Glamorgan
(Various Road, Penylan Area) (Prohibition of Through
Traffic) Order 1975*

Notice is hereby given that the County Council of South Glamorgan in exercise of its powers under Section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by the Transport Act 1968, the Local Government Act 1972 and the Road Traffic Act 1974 proposes making an Order, the general effect of which will be to prevent you, except upon the direction of a police constable in uniform, or a traffic warden, from driving your vehicle in any of the lengths of road in schedule below.

Exemptions will be permitted for the following reasons:

- (a) for the conveyance of persons, goods or merchandise to or from any premises situated on or adjacent to or accessible from any of the said lengths of road;
- (b) in connection with any building operation or demolition in or adjacent to any of the said lengths of road;
- (c) the removal of any obstruction to traffic in those lengths of road;
- (d) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of those lengths of road;
- (e) the laying, erection, allineation or repair in or adjacent to those lengths of road of any sewer or of any main pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telegraphic line as defined in the Telegraph Act 1878.

- (a) into Borough Close except for access
- (b) in the central peripheral area other than in a clockwise direction.

NORWICH CITY COUNCIL

*The City of Norwich (West Pottergate)
(Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1975*

Notice is hereby given that Norwich City Council pursuant to an arrangement entered under Section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with Norfolk County Council propose to make an Order under Sections (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972.

The effect of this Order would be to prohibit any vehicle from waiting at any time in the following lengths of road:

- (1) *West Pottergate*
 - (a) On its north side
 - (i) from its junction with the access road from Earlham Road in a westerly direction for 65 metres
 - (ii) from a point 24 metres east of its junction with the access road in an easterly direction for a distance of 36 metres and in a southerly direction for a distance of 7 metres
 - (b) On its south side from a point 13 metres west of its junction with the access road to a point 21 metres east of that junction.
