The Hounslow (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Amendment No.) Order 197

Notice is hereby given that the Greater London Council propose to make the above-mentioned Order under Sections 6 and 84D of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by the Transport Act 1968 and the Road Traffic Act 1974.

2 The general effect of the Order would be further to amend the Hounslow (Waiting and Loading Restrictions) Order 1971, so that

(a) waiting by vehicles (otherwise than for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle) would be prohibited:

(i) between 8.30 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive in the lengths of streets speci-

field in Schedule 1 to this Notice and in the first 60 feet of adjacent Sunningdale Avenue;

(ii) between 8.30 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive in the street and length of street specified in Schedule 2 to this Notice and in the first 60 feet of adjacent streets specified in Schedule 3 to this Notice;

- (b) waiting by vehicles for the purpose of delivering or or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle for a period of more than 20 minutes in the same place would be prohibited between 11 a.m. and 6.30
 - (i) on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive in the lengths of streets referred to in subparagraph (a)(i) above;
 - (ii) on Mondays to Fridays inclusive in the street and lengths of streets referred to in sub-paragraph (a)(ii) above;
- (c) the sale or offer for sale of goods from a vehicle in the street and lengths of streets referred to in sub-paragraph (a) above would be prohibited, except on a Sunday, unless there is in force a valid licence issued by the Hounslow Borough Council or the goods are immediately taken into or delivered at premises adjagate the valid forms which the promises adjagate to the valid forms which the promises and the council or the promise and the council or the coun cent to the vehicle from which the sale is effected;

- (d) the use of any vehicle or of any animal or the wearing of fancy dress or other costume, wholly or mainly for the purpose of advertising, in the street and lengths of street referred to in sub-paragraph (a) above would be prohibited.
- 3 The prohibitions referred to in paragraph 2(a) and (b) above would not apply in respect of anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or in certain circumstances, e.g., the picking up or setting down of passengers; the carrying out of statutory powers or duties; the taking in of petrol, etc., from roadside petrol stations; to licensed street traders, etc. The usual exemption relating to vehicles displaying a disabled person's "Orange Badge" would apply.
