PUBLIC HEALTH ACTS AND CLEAN AIR ACT

THE BOROUGH OF HARTLEPOOL

No. 30 Smoke Control Order 1975

Notice is hereby given that the Hartlepool Borough Council in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 11 of the above-mentioned Act on the 10th September 1975 made an Order entitled the Borough of Hartlepool No. 30 Smoke Control Order 1975 declaring the area described in the Schedule hereto to be a smoke control area which Order is about to be submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation.

Subject to the exemptions provided by the Order and by virtue of section 11 (4) of the Act if, on any day after the Order has come into operation smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the smoke control area the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £20 unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of

any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

If confirmed the Order will not come into operation before the 1st November 1976 or before a later date determined by the Secretary of State for the Environment.

Copies of the Order and of the map referred to therein may be inspected free of charge at the office of the Borough Solicitor, Municipal Buildings, Hartlepool during normal office hours during the period of 6 weeks from the 19th September 1975.

Within the said period any person who will be affected by the Order may by notice in writing to the Secretary of State for the Environment, 2 Marsham Street, London, SW1P 3EB, object to the confirmation of the Order.

POST OFFICE

POST OFFICE SCHEME P9/1975

NOTE:—The Scheme which follows this note amends the Post Office (Postal Order) Scheme 1971. The amending Scheme which comes into operation on the 29th September 1975, provides for an increase in the fee payable for postal orders for denominations from 5p up to and including £10. It revokes the Post Office (Postal Order) Amendment (No. 4) Scheme 1975 (Post Office Scheme P6/1975) which was made on the 21st February 1975.

THE POST OFFICE (POSTAL ORDER) AMENDMENT (No. 5) SCHEME 1975

Made - - - - - 2nd September 1975
Coming into operation - - - - - 29th September 1975

The Post Office, by virtue of the powers conferred upon it by section 28 of the Post Office Act 1969, and of all other powers enabling it in this behalf, hereby makes the following Scheme:

Commencement and Citation

1. This Scheme:

- shall come into operation on the 29th day of September 1975;
- may be cited as the Post Office (Postal Order) Amendment (No. 5) Scheme 1975;
- shall be read as one with the Post Office (Postal Order) Scheme 1971 (Post Office Scheme P5/1971) (hereinafter called "the Scheme"), the Post Office (Postal Order) Amendment (No. 1) Scheme 1973 (Post Office Scheme P4/1973) and the Post Office (Postal Order) Amendment (No. 2) Scheme 1973 (Post Office Scheme P9/1973).

Interpretation

2. The Interpretation Act 1889 applies for the interpretation of this Scheme as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

Fee on issue of Postal Orders

3. For the Schedule to the Scheme as substituted by the Post Office (Postal Order) Amendment (No. 4) Scheme 1975 there shall be substituted the following Schedule:
