make an Order under section 1 (1), (2), (3) and 84D (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, the effect of which will be to replace a Prohibition of Waiting at any time on the length of limited waiting on the eastern side of The Avenue extending in a northerly direction from the southern boundary of No. 1 The Avenue to the existing prohibited waiting area at its junction with Bury Road.

Exceptions are provided in the Order for (i) vehicles to wait to enable a person to board or alight or goods to be loaded or unloaded; (ii) to enable vehicles used by registered medical practitioners to wait while they are engaged upon their professional duties; and (iii) to allow any disabled person's vehicle to wait which displays in the relevant position a disabled person's badge issued by any local authority.
