

(b) provide that the parking places are to be in operation between 8.30 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive and between 8.30 a.m. and 1.30 p.m. on Saturdays (Christmas Day, Good Friday and Bank Holidays excepted);

(c) specify, in respect Schedules 2 and 3 parking places, that passenger vehicles (12 seats or less), goods carrying vehicles, motor cycles and invalid carriages may be left therein, in respect of Schedule 4 parking places, that vehicles displaying a valid residents' permit may be left therein—such permit to be issued by the Council;

(d) provide that:—

(i) in respect of Schedule 4 parking places, residents' permits, calendars, season tickets and protective covers would be issued by the Borough Council on application being made by any person residing in the controlled areas who is the owner of a passenger vehicle (12 seats or less), a goods carrying vehicle not more than seven feet 6 inches in height, a motor cycle or an invalid carriage;

(e) specify that:—

(i) in the Schedule 2 parking places, the initial charge would be at the rate of 5 new pence per twenty minutes and the maximum initial period would be 2 hours;

(ii) in the Schedule 3 parking places, the initial charge would be at the rate of 10 new pence per forty minutes and the maximum initial period would be 4 hours;

(iii) in the Schedule 4 parking places, the charge would be 12½ new pence for any period during one day. The payment of this charge is by the purchase of a parking token from the Borough Council and by the affixing of that token to the calendar combined with a valid residents' permit within the space thereon appropriate to the date on which the vehicle is left in the parking place and the calendar combined with the valid residents' permit must be displayed on the vehicle. If the vehicle displays a valid permit combined with a valid season ticket no such charge is payable. The charge for season tickets would be £2.75, £7.50 or £26 for tickets expiring at the end of one month, three months or twelve months respectively, running from the beginning of the month in which they are issued;

(iv) in respect of Schedules 2 and 3 parking places, the excess charge—payable to the Borough Council—is £3; the excess charge period is one hour: the unexpired time shown on the parking meter may be used free of charge and the period during which a vehicle may not return to a parking place in one hour; and

(f) provide that certain vehicles may wait free of charge in certain circumstances, e.g. to allow persons to board or alight (maximum 2 minutes), to load or unload (maximum 20 minutes) and vehicles left by specified disabled persons (no time limit).

The Waiting and Loading Restriction Amendment Order would slightly amend the Islington (Waiting and Loading Restriction) Order 1972 so as to:

(i) exclude Goswell Terrace from the No Waiting Restriction; and

(ii) remove the motor cycle parking area in Goswell Terrace.
