*The Nottinghamshire County Council (Bingham)
(One-Way Traffic) Order 1975*

Notice is hereby given that the Nottinghamshire County Council propose to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended aforesaid the effect of which will be to prohibit any vehicle proceeding in that length of road specified in Column 1 of the Schedule to this notice in any direction other than that specified in relation to that length of road specified in Column 2 of the said Schedule.

A copy of the proposed Order and a plan showing the length of Road affected may be inspected during normal office hours at my office at County Hall, West Bridgford, Nottingham.

Any objection to the proposed Order should be sent to the Director of Administration and County Solicitor, County Hall, West Bridgford, Nottingham, NG2 7QP, not later than 5th December 1975, and should state the grounds on which it is made.

*The Nottinghamshire County Council (Bingham)
(Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1975*

Notice is hereby given that the Nottinghamshire County Council propose to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended aforesaid the effect of which will be:

- To prohibit any vehicle waiting at any time in the lengths of road specified in the First Schedule to this notice.
- To prohibit any vehicle waiting between 08.30 hours and 18.15 hours, Monday to Saturday inclusive, in the lengths of road specified in the Second Schedule to this notice.
- To prohibit any vehicle waiting between 08.30 hours and 18.15 hours on Thursdays in the lengths of road specified in the Third Schedule to this notice.

Exemptions will be provided for in the Order so that it shall not be unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait in any of the lengths of road referred to in the Schedules to this notice for as long as may be necessary,

- to enable a person to board or alight from a vehicle;
- to enable goods to be loaded or unloaded from a vehicle;
- to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other length of road to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance improvement or reconstruction of any of the lengths of road so referred to or the laying, alteration

or repair in or near any of the lengths of road of any sewer or of any main pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telegraphic line as defined in the Telegraph Act, 1878.

- to enable the vehicle if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other length of road to be used in the service of a local authority in pursuance of of statutory powers or duties.

Nothing in Article 1 or Article 2 or Article 3 of the Order will make it unlawful to cause or permit a disabled person's vehicle which displays in the relevant position a disabled person's badge, and a parking disc (on which the driver, or other person in charge of the vehicle, has marked the time at which the period of waiting began) to wait on any of the lengths of road referred to in the said Articles for a period not exceeding 2 hours (not being a period separated by an interval of less than one hour from a previous period of waiting by the same vehicle on the same length of road).

In the Order the expression "Disabled Person's Vehicle" has the same meaning as in the Local Authorities Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Person's) (England and Wales) (Amendment) Regulations 1975. The expression "Disabled Person's Badge" has the same meaning as in the Disabled Person's (Badges for Motor Vehicles) Regulations 1975, and "Relevant Position" means:

- in the case of a vehicle fitted with a front windscreen the badge is exhibited thereon with the obverse side facing forwards on the near side of and immediately behind the windscreen;
- in the case of a vehicle not fitted with a front windscreen, the badge is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the front or near side of the vehicle.

The expression "parking disc" means a disc, issued by a Local Authority, complying with the requirements of the British Standard Specification for Parking Discs (BS No. 4631:1970) coloured Orange, and capable of showing the quarter hour period during which a period of waiting begins.

FIRST SCHEDULE

Lengths of Road at Bingham in the Borough of Rushcliffe
Prohibition of waiting at all times.

- Market Street, east side:*
Commencing at its junction with Long Acre, terminating in a northerly direction at a distance of 8 yards.
- Market Place North, north side:*
Commencing at its junction with Market Place West, terminating in an easterly direction at a distance of 30 yards.

SECOND SCHEDULE

Lengths of Road at Bingham in the Borough of Rushcliffe
Restriction of Waiting between 08.30 hours and 18.15 hours Monday to Saturday inclusive.

- Market Place South, north side:*
Commencing at its junction with Market Place East, terminating in a westerly direction at a distance of 70 yards.
- Market Place South, south side:*
Commencing at its junction with Market Street, terminating in an easterly direction at a distance of 44 yards.
- Market Place West, east side:*
Commencing at its junction with Market Place North, terminating in a southerly direction at its junction with Market Place South a distance of 40 yards.
- Newgate Street, both sides:*
Commencing at its junction with Kirk Hill and Fairfield Street, terminating in an easterly direction at its junction with Moor Lane and Market Place West a distance of 234 yards.
- Needham Street and Union Street, both sides:*
Commencing at its junction with Long Acre, terminating in a northerly and easterly direction at its
