## AVON COUNTY COUNCIL

*County of Avon (Hopechapel Hill and Joy Hill Area, Bristol) (Weight Restriction) Order 197*

Notice is hereby given that the County Council of Avon propose to make an Order under Section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles, the unladen weight of which exceeds 2 tons from proceeding in the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Notice.

Exceptions to the Order will be provided for the conveyance of persons, goods or merchandise to or from any premises; building or demolition operations; the removal of obstructions to traffic; the maintenance of the road and services therein; fire brigade, police or ambulance purposes; the conveyance of goods for sale and a local authority or water authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties.

The alternative route is via Hotwell Road, Clifton Vale and Cornwallis Crescent.

A copy of the proposed Order, together with a map and a Statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order, may be inspected at the undermentioned offices (Sixth Floor) during the hours of 8.30 a.m. to 5 p.m. on Mondays to Thursdays and 8.30 a.m. to 4.30 p.m. on Fridays.

Objections to the proposal, together with the grounds on which they are made must be sent in writing to the undersigned within 28 days of the date of this Notice.—Dated 8th December 1975.

## AVON COUNTY COUNCIL

*County of Avon (Southmead Road and Doncaster Road, Bristol) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1975*

Notice is hereby given that on 4th December 1975, the County Council of Avon made an Order under Section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974, the effect of which is:

- (1) to prohibit any vehicle to wait at any time in the lengths of road specified in Schedule I to this Notice and
- (2) to restrict any vehicle from waiting for more than one hour in any two hours between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays (both days inclusive) in the lengths of road specified in Schedule II to this Notice.

Exceptions are provided in the Order for vehicles to wait for so long as may be necessary for a person to board or alight, to enable goods to be loaded or unloaded, to en-

able a vehicle to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance of the road or services therein, to enable a vehicle to be used in pursuance of statutory powers or duties and for a period of up to two hours for users of cars displaying the disabled person's badge and parking disc (in 1) above.

The Order will come into operation on 15th December 1975, and a copy thereof together with a map may be inspected at the undermentioned offices (Sixth Floor) during the hours of 8.30 a.m. to 5 p.m. on Mondays to Thursdays and 8.30 a.m. to 4.30 p.m. on Fridays.

Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the relevant section of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may within six weeks after the date on which the Order was made, apply to the High Court for this purpose.
