The Treasury hereby give notice that in accordance with the powers conferred upon them by the National Loans Act 1968 (1968 c. 13) the following rates of interest shall be charged on loans made by the Public Works Loan Commissioners on or after 13th December 1975.

Different rates of interest apply according to whether the principal of a loan is repaid by instalments or at maturity.
