The Order shall come ito operation on the 15th December 1975.

## WATFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Borough of Watford St. Albans Road (Dome Roundabout and Balmoral Road) (Bus Lane) Experimental Traffic Order, 197 .

Notice is hereby given that the Watford Borough Council pursuant to arrangements made under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with the Hertfordshire County Council propose to make the above mentioned Order under section 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IV of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and the Road Traffic Act 1974.

2. The general effect of the proposed Order will be:

(A) to prohibit for an experimental initial period of 6 months all vehicles from entering or proceeding in the area of the carriageway (to be known as "the bus lane") lying within or adjacent to that length of St. Albans Road between the Dome Roundabout and Balmoral Road specified in Schedule 1 to this notice and between the eastern kerb line of that road and a single white line (which will be broken by gaps opposite the joining roads) marked on the carriageway of that road during the times between 7 a.m. and 10 a.m. on all days.

The prohibition will not apply to:

(a) a stage or express carriage on a scheduled service;

(b) a school or works bus;

(c) a pedal cycle;

(d) a vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance

or police purposes;

(e) any vehicle being used in connection with the removal of any obstruction in the bus lane;

(f) any vehicle being used for purposes in connection with statutory powers or duties of the local authority or the supply of gas, water or electricity, or in connection with any building operation, demolition or excavation in or adjacent to the bus lane;

(g) any vehicle which enters the bus lane for the sole purpose of waiting for a period not exceeding 2 minutes to enable a disabled, injured or blind person whose ability to walk is seriously impared, to board or alight from that vehicle;

(h) any vehicle if the driver thereof is obliged to enter or proceed in the bus lane in order to avoid an accident:

accident;
(i) any vehicle if the driver thereof is required by law

to stop;
(j) the loading or unloading of goods from a vehicle at premises having an entrance from the side of the road on which the bus service is situated and no other entrance: provided that such loading as can be carried out only from the bus lane shall take place only whilst no prohibition of loading or unloading on the bus lane by virtue of any other Order is in force;

(k) any vehicle gaining entrance to off-street loading

facilities or garaging;

(1) any vehicle which enters or proceeds in the bus lane:

(i) from any road if that vehicle forthwith leaves the bus lane through the gap in the single white line situated opposite and adjacent to the junction of that road with the bus lane; or

(ii) from any part of St. Albans Road which does not comprise the bus lane through any gap in the single white line if that vehicle forthwith enters the road which lies opposite that gap, or

(iii) from any vehicular accessway or carriage crossing over the footway adjoining the bus lane if that vehicle forthwith leaves the bus lane at a point

that vehicle forthwith leaves the bus lane at a point opposite that vehicular accessway or carriage cross-

(iv) from any part of St. Albans Road which does not comprise the bus lane at a point opposite any vehicular accessway or carriage crossing over the footway adjoining that bus lane if that vehicle forthwith enters that vehicular accessway or carriage crossing;

(B) To prohibit driving at all times in Windsor Road between Sandringham Road and St. Albans Road other than in a westerly direction.

(C) To prohibit the making of a right-hand turn at all times from St. Albans Road into Leggatts Wood Avenue.

(D) To apply in a modfied form the provisions of the Borough of Watford (North Watford) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1972 so that:

(a) the existing one hour in two limited waiting by vehicles which applies in the side of road specified in Schedule 2 to this notice is suspended during the hours of 7 a.m. and 10 a.m. Mondays to Saturdays, and substituted by a prohibition on waiting by vehicles whether for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle during this period.

(b) the existing prohibition on waiting by vehicles for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle which applies in the side of road specified in Schedule 3 to this notice will also apply between 7 a.m. and 8 a.m. and 9.30 a.m. and 10 a.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive.

(E) To apply in a modified form the provisions of the Borough of Watford (North Watford) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1973 so that the existing prohibition on waiting by vehicles for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle which applies in the side of road specified in Schedule 4 to this rection will also apply between 7 and Schedule 4 to this notice will also apply between 7 a.m. and 8 a.m. and 9.30 a.m. and 10 a.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive.
