

(vi) the charge for season tickets would be £7.50 or £27 for tickets expiring at the end of 3 months or 12 months respectively, running from the beginning of the month in which they are issued;

(vii) in respect of the Schedule 3, 4 and 5 parking places the excess charge payable to the City Council would be £4; in respect of Schedule 6 parking places the excess charge would be £1; the excess charge period in all cases is 1 hour; the period during which vehicles may not return to a parking place is 1 hour and the unexpired time shown on the parking meter may be used free of charge;

(i) provide that certain vehicles may wait free of charge in certain circumstances, e.g. to allow persons to board or alight (maximum 2 minutes) to load or unload (maximum 20 minutes) and vehicles left by specified disabled persons (no time limit).

The effect of the proposed Waiting and Loading Restriction Order would be to make consequential amendments to the City of Westminster (Waiting and Loading Restriction) Order 1972 (as amended) and the restrictions imposed by the aforesaid Order would apply to the areas of highways formerly occupied by parking places and which would not be occupied by the proposed parking places. The proposed Order would extend the restrictions in Orange Street, alter the cycle parking area in Horse and Dolphin Yard and designate new cycle parking areas in Bedfordbury and James Street (Covent Garden).

A copy of each of the proposed Orders, of the Parking Places (St. Marylebone and Westminster) Order 1965 and the City of Westminster (Waiting and Loading Restriction) Order 1972 (and of the Orders which have either amended any of those Orders or to which the provisions of any of those Orders have been applied), of the maps which indicate each length of highway to which the proposed Orders relate and of the City Council's statement of reasons for applying for the proposed Orders may be inspected during the period of 21 days from 12th December 1975 in Room 14.08, Westminster City Hall, Victoria Street, London S.W.1, on Mondays to Fridays between 9.30 a.m. and 4.30 p.m. and at the Charing Cross Library, 4 Charing Cross Road, London W.C.2, between 10 a.m. and 7 p.m. Mondays to Fridays and 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. Saturdays.

Any person wishing to object to these proposals may do so by sending to the Director of Planning and Transportation (PT/TD/PO/R), Greater London Council, County Hall, London, SE1 7PB, notice in writing of his objection, stating the grounds thereof, within the above-mentioned period of 21 days.
