Middlesbrough Borough Council (Restriction of Waiting) (Various Roads) (No. 4) Order, 1975 The

Notice is hereby given that the Middlesbrough Borough Council, acting as agent for the highway authority Cleveland County Council, have made an Order under sections 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transact Act, 1967 amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968, and of all other powers them enabling in that behalf and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Cleveland County Police.

The Order comes into operation on the 18th December 1975.

The effect of this Order will be to restrict the waiting vehicles in certain sides and lengths of roads in Middlesbrough as set out below and to revoke references to some of these roads in earlier Orders.

- Unnamed Road between Area 1 Circulation Road and Bolckow Street, on both sides of this road.

Dunning Street.

- (a) the southern end of the cul-de-sac head from the east kerbline of Dunning Street in a westerly direc-tion to the eastern boundary of the Municipal Buildings;
- (b) the east side, from a point 40 metres south of the south kerbline of Corporation Road for a distance of 30 metres.
- (ii) No Waiting between the hours of 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday to Saturday for a period longer than 30 minutes with no return within 2 hours
  - Corporation Road, north side, from a point 36 metres east of the east kerbline of Gurney Street to a point 130 metres from the east kerbline of Gurney Street.
- (iii) No Waiting at any time between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. Monday to Saturday

Durham Street

- (a) east side, from the south side of the junction of Durham Street with Vulcan Street to the northern kerbline of Commercial Street;
- (b) the east side, from the southern kerbline of Commercial Street to the northern kerbline of Hudson Street :
- (c) west side, from the south side of the junction of Durham Street with Vulcan Street to the northern kerbline of Commercial Street;
- (d) the west side from the southern kerbline of Com-mercial Street for a distance of 70 metres in a southerly direction.

(iv) No Waiting 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. on any day

Howard Street, both sides.

(v) No Waiting between 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday to Saturday
