- (b) designate 2-hour and residents' parking places in the highways specified in Schedule 3 and 4 respectively to this notice;
- (c) provide that a parking card will be issued by the City Council on application being made by any person residing in the streets listed in Schedule 1 to this notice who is the owner of a passenger vehicle (12 seats or less), a goods carrying vehicle the overall height of which does not exceed 8 feet, a motor cycle or an invalid carriage;
- invalid carriage;
 (d) provide that a parking card issued in respect of the residents' parking places designated by the proposed Order or by the City of Westminster (Parking Places) (No. 3) Order 1975 or by other Orders to which the provisions of that Order has been applied or which have amended that Order will be valid for use in connection with the leaving of a vehicle in a residents' parking place designated by either of those Orders;
 (e) to apply to the proposed parking places the provisions of the City of Westminster (Parking Places) (No. 3) Order 1975 (as amended) so that, in particular:

 (i) the parking places would be in operation between
- (i) the parking places would be in operation between the hours of 8.30 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive and between 8.30 a.m. and 1.30 p.m. on Saturdays (Christmas Day, Good Friday and Bank

Fridays inclusive and between 8.30 a.m. and 1.30 p.m. on Saturdays (Christmas Day, Good Friday and Bank Holidays excepted); (ii) in respect of Schedule 3 parking places, passenger vehicles (12 seats or less), goods carrying vehicles, motor cycles or invalid carriages may be left; (iii) in respect of Schedule 4 parking places vehicles displaying a valid parking card issued by the City Council may be left; (iv) in respect of Schedule 3 parking places, the initial charge would be at the rate of 10 new pence per 20 minutes (maximum 2 hours); (v) in respect of Schedule 4 parking places, the charge would be 20 new pence for any period during any one day. The payment of this charge is by the purchase of a parking token from the City Council and by the affixing of that token to the calendar combined with a valid permit (heretofore referred to as a parking card) within the space thereon appro-priate to the date on which the vehicle is left in the parking place and the parking card must be displayed on the vehicle. If the vehicle displays a valid permit combined with a valid season ticket (also heretofore referred to as a parking card) no such charge is payable; (vi) the charge for season tickets is £7:50 or £27 for payable ;

(vi) the charge for season tickets is £7.50 or £27 for tickets expiring at the end of 3 months and 12 months respectively running from the beginning of the month in which they are issued;

in which they are issued; (vii) in respect of Schedule 3 parking places, the excess charge—payable to the City Council—is $\pounds 4$; the excess charge period is one hour; the period during which vehicles may not return to a parking place is one hour and the unexpired time shown on the parking meter may be used free of charge; (viii) certain vehicles may wait free of charge in certain circumstances, e.g. to allow persons to board or alight (maximum 2 minutes), to load or unload (maximum 20 minutes) and vehicles left by specified disabled persons (no time limit)

disabled persons (no time limit). The effect of the proposed Waiting and Loading Restric-

tion Order would be to make consequential amendments to the City of Westminster (Waiting and Loading Restric-tion) Order 1972 (as amended) and the restrictions imposed by the aforesaid Order would apply to the areas of highway formerly occupied by parking places and which would not be occupied by the proposed parking places.

The proposed Order would:

(a) reduce the length of an existing loading bay in Hanover Street,

(b) reduce a cycle parking area in the northern arm of Spring Gardens,

(c) redesignate a cycle parking area in Cleveland Place, and

(d) designate new cycle parking areas in Arlington Street and Sackville Street.

the proposed Orders relate and of the City Council's statement of reasons for applying for the Orders may be inspected during the period of 21 days from 19th December 1975 in Room 14.08, Westminster City Hall, Victoria Street, London S.W.1, on Mondays to Fridays, between 9.30 a.m. and 4.30 p.m., and at the Mayfair Library, 25 South Audley Street, London S.W.1, between 9.30 a.m. and 7 p.m., Mondays to Fridays, and 9.30 a.m. to 1 p.m., Saturdays.

Any person wishing to object to these proposals may do so by sending to the Director of Planning and Trans-portation (PT/TD/PO/R), Greater London Council, County Hall, London, SE1 7PB, notice in writing of his objection, stating the grounds thereof, within the above-mentioned period of 21 days.
