CUSTOMS AND EXCISE

NOTICE OF SEIZURE UNDER THE CUSTOMS AND EXCISE ACT, 1952

30th December 1975.

Pursuant to section 275 (5) of the Customs and Excise
Act 1952, and paragraph 1 of the 7th Schedule thereto, the
Commissioners of Customs and Excise hereby give notice
that by virtue of the powers contained in the Customs

and Excise Acts and enactments amending those Acts, certain
goods, namely:

2 reels 16 mm. colour/sound film entitled "The
Search"—imported into the United Kingdom and
found at Sutton Coldfield Postal Depot on or about
the 14th August 1975

have been seized as liable to forfeiture upon the grounds
that the said goods are indecent or obscene articles which
were imported contrary to the prohibition contained in
section 42 of the Customs Consolidation Act 1876. Where-
by and by force of section 44 of the Customs and Excise
Act 1952, the said goods are liable to forfeiture.

If you claim that the said goods are not liable to forfei-
ture you must within one month from the date of this
notice of seizure give notice of your claim in accordance
with the said Schedule to the said Act specifying the name
and address of a solicitor in the United Kingdom who is
authorised to accept service of process and to act on
your behalf. In default of such a notice the said goods will
be deemed to have been duly condemned as forfeited and
will be liable to be disposed of in such a manner as the
Commissioners of Customs and Excise may direct. If you
make such a claim within the time aforesaid, legal pro-
ceeding will be taken for the condemnation thereof.
