### The A.3(M) Horndean-Bedhampton Motorway (Side Roads and Appropriation) (Variation) Order 197

The Secretary of State for the Environment hereby gives notice that he proposes in relation to the A.3(M) Horndean-Bedhampton Motorway in the county of Hampshire to make under sections 13 and 286 of the Highways Act 1959 an Order which will—

- (a) vary some of the provisions of the A.3(M) Horndean-Bedhampton Motorway (Side Roads and Appropriation) Order 1975 shown on Site Plan No. 5 to that Order, which was made on 19th August 1975. The provisions to be varied relate to the improvement of Hurstville Drive, the improvement at the western end of Hulbert Road, and part of the new highway (marked "A" on the plan) on the western side of the Hulbert Road Interchange; and
- (b) authorise him to improve, raise, lower, or otherwise alter highways and to construct a new highway; and
- (c) provide for the transfer of the said new highway to the County Council of Hampshire as from the date on which he notifies the Council that the new highway has been completed and is open for through traffic.
