WATER ACTS

The following notice is in substitution for that which appeared on page 16308 of the London Gazette dated 23rd December 1975:

WELSH NATIONAL WATER DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY

HEREFORD WATER DIVISION

Water Act, 1958

Notice is hereby given that because of exceptional shortage of rain the Welsh National Water Development Authority, in respect of the Hereford Water Division, in pursuance of powers contained in section 1 of the Water Act 1958, is applying to the Secretary of State for Wales for an Order authorising it to abstract water from the River Wye at the rate of 500,000 gallons per day at a point in the Parish of Walford in the County of Hereford and Worcester at map reference S.O. 5841 1973 or thereabouts by means of a submersible pump and to lay a temporary pipeline and ancillary works from that point to an existing treatment works at Castle Brook, for a maximum period of six months.

The said pipeline will pass through the land specified in the Schedule hereto and a plan of the said pipeline is available for inspection at the offices of the Authority at Coughton Depot, Walford Road, Coughton, near Ross-on-Wye between the hours of 10 a.m. and 12 noon and 2 p.m. to 4 p.m. on Monday to Friday commencing Monday the 19th January 1976.

The said Order will also contain power to lay a supply of electricity from the former railway embankment adjacent to the saw mills in enclosure 209b to the point on the river bank where the abstraction will take place together with rights of access to and maintenance of the said pipeline and ancillary works by the Authority.

Any objections to the proposed Order should be made in writing to the Secretary of State for Wales, Welsh Office, Cathays Park, Cardiff quoting reference LG/WS/3436/9 within seven days of the date of publication of this notice

and should state the grounds of any objection. It is requested that a copy of the objection may at the same time be sent to the undersigned.

Objections to the notice published in the *Hereford Times* dated the 26th December which appeared on the 24th December and the *London Gazette* dated the 23rd December 1975 need not be resubmitted.
