NEW TOWN ACT 1965

BASILDON DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION
EVERSLEY HOUSING AREA*Compulsory Purchase Order 1975 No. 1*

Notice is hereby given that the Basildon Development Corporation, in pursuance of their powers under section 7 of the New Towns Act 1965, on the 10th December 1975, made an Order which has been submitted for confirmation by the Secretary of State for the Environment, authorising them to purchase compulsorily for the purposes of the New Town of Basildon (or incidental thereto) the lands described in the Schedule hereto, being lands within the area designated by the Basildon New Town (Designation) Order, 1949.

A copy of the Order and of the map referred to therein, have been deposited at the offices of the Corporation at Gifford House, London Road, Bowers Gifford, Basildon, Essex, and will be open for inspection without payment of fee during the usual office hours.

Any objection to the Order must be made in writing, stating the grounds of the objection, and addressed to the Secretary of State for the Environment, Marsham Street, London, S.W.1, before the 23rd February 1976.

The Secretary of State is not, in all cases, required to arrange for objections to be heard by a person appointed by him for that purpose. It is important, therefore, that an objection should include a full statement in writing of the grounds on which the objection is made as the objector may have no further opportunity to make such a statement.

Any owner or occupier of any land to which the Order relates may send to Basildon Development Corporation at the address below, a request in writing to serve him with a notice that the Order has been confirmed, and naming the place where a copy of the Order and of the map and of any descriptive matter annexed thereto may be seen. Such request should contain a statement of the name, postal address and the interest in the land of the owner occupier, and particulars sufficient to enable the extent and boundaries of the land to be identified.

ACT 1949*Diversion of Footpath Orders*

Notice is hereby given of the proposed diversion of a public footpath shown as footpath No. 12 on the former Wakefield Rural District Council's Definitive Footpath plan.

The existing footpath runs north-south for a distance of approximately 340 metres from the Lord Nelson Public House, High Street, Crigglestone, to a point adjacent to 196 Painthorpe Lane, Painthorpe.

The proposed diversion will run through the residential development under construction by Messrs. Asquith Ltd. and follow the footpath of the approved highway layout.

NATIONAL COAL BOARD

OPENCAST COAL ACT 1958

Notice is hereby given that the National Coal Board intend to submit an application entitled the Drym Extension South Application 1976 to the Secretary of State for an authorisation under section 1 of the Opencast Coal Act 1958, to work coal by opencast operations or to cause or permit coal to be worked by such operations and for an Order under section 15 of that Act suspending a public right of way. The land which the National Coal Board require to occupy in this connection and the right of way to which the application for the Order relates are described below. A copy of the application and of the accompanying map may be seen between the hours of 9 a.m. and 5 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive at the National Coal Board's Northern Area Office, Banwen, West Glamorgan. Any objection to the application must be made in writing to the Secretary of State for Energy, c/o Welsh Office (EP4), Government Buildings, Gabalfa, Cardiff CF4 4YL, before 23rd February 1976, and should state whether it is to the grant of the authorisation or to the making of the Order suspending a public right of way and the grounds of objection.

Description of Land

The land which is about 288 acres in extent is situated in the Community of Dylais Higher in the Borough of Neath in the County of West Glamorgan. It lies immediately to the south of Onllwyn and the A.4109 public road, its centre being about 2 kilometres east-north-east of Seven Sisters and 1.5 kilometres south-west of Dyffryn Cellwen. About 261 acres of the land lie within the existing authorised Drym and Maesgwyn Cap Extension Sites.

Description of Public Right of Way

Part of the footpath from Bridleway No. 9, near the site of the now destroyed Old Houses, Onllwyn, to Sarn Helen (Roman Road) in the Community of Dylais Higher, being the part which runs from the point (up to which the footpath is already temporarily suspended) about 900 metres north-west of Elwyn Colliery (Private Mine) southwards for a distance of about 115 metres.
