ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1967

The Trunk Road (Aberystwyth) (Prohibition of Right-Hand Turn) (Experimental) Order 1976

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for Wales has made an Order under section 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and by Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974 which shall come into operation on 30th January 1976. The effect of the Order is that no person shall cause or permit any vehicle proceeding in a general westerly direction in that length of the Fishguard—Bangor (Menai Suspension Bridge) Trunk Road (A.487) known as Northgate Street at Aberystwyth in the County of Dyfed to make a right-hand turn into Vaenor Street.

A copy of the Order, together with a plan and a statement of reasons for making the Order, may be seen during normal office hours at the offices of the Ceredigion District Council, Town Hall, Aberystwyth, during a period of 6 weeks from 22nd January 1976.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, or that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within the aforesaid period of 6 weeks, apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained therein.

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1967

The Trunk Roads (Aberystwyth) (Traffic Regulation) (Experimental) (Variation) Order 1976

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for Wales has made an Order under sections 9 and 84D of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and by Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974 which shall come into operation on 30th January 1976. The effect of the Order is:

- (a) to cancel the prohibition of persons causing vehicles from turning right from Penglais Road—Northgate Street into North Road contained in the Trunk Roads (Aberystwyth) (Traffic Regulation) (Experimental Order 1975 (hereinafter referred to as "the 1975 Order");

(b) to insert an additional exemption for vehicles bearing both a disabled person's badge and a parking disc, as detailed below, into the 1975 Order; and

(c) to amend the period of operation of the limited waiting contained in the 1975 Order from 45 minutes in any 2 hours between the hours of 8.30 a.m. and 6 p.m. on any day to 45 minutes in any 2 hours between the hours of 8.30 a.m. and 6 p.m. on any day other than a Sunday.

The exemption referred to in (b) above is one to allow vehicles bearing both a disabled person's badge and a parking disc to wait for a period not exceeding 2 hours (not being a period of waiting separated by an interval of less than one hour from a previous period of waiting by the same vehicle on the same side or in the same length of road) on any of the sides of road or in any of the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 to the 1975 Order. (Schedule 1 to the 1975 Order comprises sides and lengths of road on which the waiting of vehicles is prohibited.)

A copy of the Order and a copy of the 1975 Order, together with a plan and a statement of reasons for making the Order, may be seen during normal office hours at the offices of the Ceredigion District Council, Town Hall, Aberystwyth, during a period of 6 weeks from 22nd January 1976.
