CREWE AND NANTWICH BOROUGH COUNCIL

Borough of Crewe and Nantwich (Crewe No. 3) (Prohibition of Waiting) (Fifth Amendment) Order 1976

Notice is hereby given that on the 23rd February 1976, the Crewe and Nantwich Borough Council pursuant to arrangements made with the Cheshire County Council under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972, in exercise of the powers of the said County Council made an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, and Schedule 19 of the Local Government Act 1972 and of all other enabling powers.

The effect of this Order is to prohibit waiting by vehicles in the lengths of street detailed in the first column for the times specified in the second column in the Schedule below.

Exemptions will permit waiting for the purposes of loading and unloading and for picking up and setting down passengers and limited waiting for disabled persons' vehicles.

CREWE AND NANTWICH BOROUGH COUNCIL

Borough of Crewe and Nantwich (Weston Close, Crewe) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1976

Notice is hereby given, that on the 23rd February 1976 the Crewe and Nantwich Borough Council pursuant to arrangements made with the Cheshire County Council under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972, in exercise of the powers of the said County Council made an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and Schedule 19 of the Local Government Act 1972 and of all other enabling powers.

The effect of this Order is to prohibit waiting by vehicles in those lengths of Weston Close hitherto unrestricted by the Borough of Crewe (Weston Close) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1968 for a longer period than forty minutes or if a period of less than three hours has elapsed since the last period of waiting of the same vehicle.

Exemptions will permit waiting for the purposes of loading and unloading and for picking up and setting down passengers and limited waiting for disabled persons' vehicles.

ELLESMERE PORT BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Borough of Ellesmere Port (Wilkinson Street) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1976

Notice is hereby given that the Ellesmere Port Borough Council (on behalf of the Cheshire County Council pursuant to an arrangement entered into under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972) propose to make an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and Schedule 19 of the Local Government Act 1972, the effect of which will be to prohibit the waiting of vehicles between 7 a.m. and 7 p.m. on both sides of Wilkinson Street from its junction with Westminster Road in a south-westerly direction for a distance of 65 feet.

Exceptions will be made in the Order to enable vehicles to wait for so long as may be necessary for the purposes of picking up and setting down passengers, loading and unloading goods, building operations and demolition work, the removal of any obstructions to traffic, road maintenance and repairs to services therein, Post Office services and other statutory duties.
