LEICESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

The Leicestershire (Parish of Wymondham) (Weight Restriction) Order 197

Notice is hereby given that the Leicestershire County Council propose to make an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, the effect of which will be to prohibit any vehicle, the unladen weight of which exceeds 3 tons, from proceeding along that length of road, part of which is known as Cordhill Lane, Edmondthorpe from its junction with route C99 in a westerly then generally south-westerly direction to its junction with route C120.

The Order will contain certain exemptions including one for vehicles needing to gain access to premises or land adjoining the road, for the purposes of conveying persons goods or merchandise to or from such premises, for the agricultural use of such land and for the maintenance of the road.

GREATER MANCHESTER COUNTY COUNCIL

The Greater Manchester County (Rock Street, Oldham) (Prohibition of Driving) (County) Order 1975

Notice is hereby given that on the 17th February 1976 the Greater Manchester County Council made this Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, the effect of which is to prohibit the driving of vehicles into and out of Rock Street at its junction with the westerly carriageway of St. Mary's Way, Oldham.

The Greater Manchester County (Rock Street, Oldham) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) (County) Order 1975.

Notice is hereby given that on the 17th February 1976 the Greater Manchester County Council made an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, the effect of which is to prohibit waiting:

(a) at any time on the following lengths of road:

Rock Street, Oldham,

(a) south side from a point 123 metres east of Lord Street to a point 153 metres east of that street;

(b) at a point 153 metres east of Lord Street on the south side to a point directly opposite on the north side;

(b) on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive on the following length of road:

Rock Street, Oldham, south side from a point 37 metres east of Lord Street to a point 123 metres east of that street.

The County Borough of Oldham (Town Centre) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1973 has been amended where it was inconsistent with the above proposals.

The Order contains exemptions to permit waiting for the purposes of boarding or alighting, loading or unloading, the removal of furniture, funerals, building operations or work on or under the lengths of road. Disabled person's vehicles displaying the relevant disabled person's badge will be allowed to wait for up to 2 hours, return prohibited within 1 hour, except where a loading/unloading ban is in force. A copy of the Order, which comes into operation on the 22nd March 1976 and a map showing the road to which it relates may be inspected between the hours of 9 a.m. and 4.30 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays at:

(a) County Secretary's Office, County Hall (Minshall Street entrance), Piccadilly Gardens, Manchester; or

(b) The Borough Secretary's Office, Town Hall, Oldham.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirements of that Act or of any instruments made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order you may within 6 weeks from the 17th February apply to the High Court for this purpose.
