HIGHWAYS ACTS 1959 TO 1971  
*The Fishguard-Bangor Trunk Road*

*(Alexandra Road and other roads, Aberystwyth) Order 197*

The Secretary State for Wales hereby gives notice that he proposes in relation to the above-mentioned Trunk Road at Aberystwyth in the County of Dyfed to make an Order under section 7 of the Highways Act 1959, the effect of which will be that on the date of the coming into operation of the Order the existing highways known as Alexandra Road and Thespian Street in Aberystwyth aforesaid will become trunk roads and the length of trunk road known as Chalybeate Street in Aberystwyth aforesaid will cease to be a trunk road.

Copies of the draft Order and of the relevant plan may be inspected free of charge at all reasonable hours from 25th March 1976 to 11th May 1976 at the Welsh Office, Roads Department, Graham Buildings, Newport Road, Cardiff, and at the offices of Dyfed County Council, Highways and Transportation Department, Johnstown, Carmarthen and Ceredigion District Council, Town Hall, Aberystwyth.

Any person may not later than 11th May 1976 object to the making of the Order, by notice to the Secretary of State, at the Welsh Office, Roads Department, Graham Buildings, Newport Road, Cardiff, CF2 1YU, quoting reference WR 11/2/31 and stating the grounds of objection.

## Y SWYDDFA GYMREIG

*The Trunk Road (The Bulwark, Brecon) (Bus Stops)*  
*(Clearway) Order 1976*

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for Wales has made an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, which shall come into operation on the 1st May 1976, and the effect of the Order is to prohibit vehicles other than buses, from waiting between 7 a.m. and 7 p.m. on any day at any bus stop in the length of road specified in the Schedule where the carriageway at that stop is marked (a) as a bus stop, and (b) with a broad yellow line adjacent to the edge of the carriageway ("the authorised markings").

Although the Order includes every bus stop in the length of road specified in the Schedule, it should be noted that the provisions of the Order which prohibit waiting will only apply to those bus stops which the Secretary of State has marked with authorised markings.

While the Order remains in force it will enable the Secretary of State at any time to lay or remove the authorised markings at or from any bus stop in the specified length of road or to adjust the position in that length of road of the authorised markings, as traffic conditions may require.

Other vehicles are permitted to wait at the bus stops with authorised markings where necessary for:—

1. The removal of an obstruction to traffic;
2. the maintenance of the road and in exercise of statutory powers with permission of the local authority; and
3. reasons of emergency.

A copy of the Order, together with a plan and a statement of reasons for making the Order, may be seen during normal office hours at the offices of the Brecknock Borough Council, Oxford House, The Watton, Brecon, and the Powys County Council, Powys County Hall, Llandrindod Wells, Powys, during a period of 6 weeks from 16th March 1976.

Copies of the Order may be obtained free of charge, on application to the Secretary of State, Welsh Office, Roads Department, (Y Swyddfa Gymreig, Adran Ffyrdd), Graham Buildings, 139 Newport Road, Cardiff, CF2 1YU, quoting the reference R15/222/21.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, or that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may within 6 weeks of the 16th March apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained therein.

## SCHEDULE

That length of the Raglan-Llandoverly Trunk Road (A40) known as the Bulwark, at Brecon in the County of Powys, which extends from its junction with High Street Inferior to its junction with Lion Street.
