TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971

The Secretary of State for Wales hereby gives notice that, he has made an Order under section 209 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971 to authorise the stopping up of that length of highway specified in the Schedule to this notice to enable development to be carried out in accordance with planning permission granted under Part III of that Act.

SCHEDULE

The highway to be stopped up is at Grangetown in the City of Cardiff in the county of South Glamorgan. It is shown by zebra hatching on the deposited plan and is that length of Hewell Street which extends from its junction with Holmsdale Street in a northerly direction for a distance of 62 yards.
