

WYRE BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Borough of Wyre (Various Streets, Fleetwood, Poulton-le-Fylde and Thornton Cleveleys) (Prohibition and restriction of Waiting) Order 1976.

Notice is hereby given that the Wyre Borough Council as agents of the Lancashire County Council propose to make an Order under sections 1 (1), (2) and (3) and 84 (D) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended varying and extending traffic restrictions at Fleetwood, Poulton-le-Fylde and Thornton Cleveleys.

The effect of the proposed Order will be as follows:

(a) It will prohibit the waiting of vehicles 24 hours daily in parts of the following roads:

(b) It will prohibit the waiting of vehicles 24 hours daily during the months of May to September inclusive in parts of the following roads:

<i>Fleetwood.</i>	Shaftesbury Avenue.
Green Drive.	The Bay.

(c) It will prohibit the waiting of vehicles between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m.—on any day on both sides of Copse Road, Fleetwood from 440.0 metres south-west of its junction with Station Road for a distance of 580.0 metres in a south-westerly direction.

(d) It will prohibit the waiting of vehicles between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m.—on Monday to Saturday inclusive on the north-eastern side of Poulton Street, Fleetwood, from 9.0 metres north-west of its junction with Lord Street to 9.0 metres north-west of a point opposite to the northern kerb of Poulton Road.

(e) It will prohibit the waiting of vehicles between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m.—on a Monday, Tuesday or Friday in parts of the following roads:

(f) It will prohibit waiting for a longer period than one hour (no return within one hour) between 8 a.m. and

6 p.m. on Monday to Saturday inclusive in parts of the following roads:

<i>Poulton-le-Fylde.</i>	Nutter Road.
Lockwood Avenue.	Rossall Road.
<i>Thornton Cleveleys.</i>	Victoria Road West.
Cleveleys Avenue.	

(g) It will prohibit waiting for a longer period than one hour (no return within one hour) between 10 a.m. and 6 p.m.—on Monday to Saturday inclusive, on the northern side of Queens Square, Poulton-le-Fylde from 10.0 metres south-west of Chapel Street for a distance of 35.0 metres in a south-westerly direction.

(h) It will prohibit waiting for a longer period than one hour (no return within one hour) between 8.30 p.m. and 11.30 p.m.—on Monday to Saturday inclusive, on the eastern side of Fleetwood Road North, Thornton Cleveleys from 182.5 metres south-west of Gordon Avenue for a distance of 49.0 metres in a south-westerly direction.

Exemptions will be provided in the Order for the purpose of boarding, alighting, loading and unloading, building and road works the maintenance of essential services and the delivery or collection of postal packets by vehicles in the service of the Post Office.

A copy of the proposed Order, a statement of reasons and maps showing the sides and lengths of road to which the proposed Order relates may be inspected at the Town Hall, Poulton-le-Fylde, and at the Council Offices, Fleetwood Road South, Thornton Cleveleys, during normal office hours.

Objections to the proposed Order together with the grounds on which they are made must be sent in writing to the undersigned by the 21st April 1976.

The Borough of Wyre (Amounderness Way) (Prohibition of Right Hand Turn) Order, 1976

Notice is hereby given that the Wyre Borough Council as agents for the Lancashire County Council propose to make an Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, the effect of which will be to prohibit any person from causing any vehicle proceeding in a westerly direction on Amounderness Way in the Borough of Wyre to make a right hand turn into the gap in the central reserve at a point 140.0 metres west of Old Mains Lane.
