3. The Bills will be issued and paid at the Bank of England.

4. Each Tender must be for an amount not less than £50,000, and must specify the date on which the Bills required are to be dated and the net amount per cent. (being a multiple of one new halfpenny) which will be given for the amount applied for. Separate Tenders must be lodged for Bills of different dates.

5. Tenders must be made through a London Banker, Discount House or Broker.

6. Notification will be sent on the same day as Tenders are received to the persons whose Tenders are accepted in whole or in part. Payment in full of the amounts due in respect of such accepted Tenders must be made to the Bank of England by means of cash or by draft or cheque drawn on the Bank of England not later than 1.30 p.m. on the day on which the relative Bills are to be dated.

#### ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT, 1967

##### *The Trunk Road (Aberystwyth) (Traffic Regulation) (Experimental) (Variation) (No. 2) Order 1976*

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for Wales has made an Order under sections 9 and 84D of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968 and by Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act, 1974 which shall come into operation on 27th April 1976. The effect of the Order is to further vary the Trunk Road (Aberystwyth) (Traffic Regulation) (Experimental) Order 1975 as follows:

- to prohibit waiting, loading or unloading at any time on either of the sides of road specified in Schedule 1 to this notice;
- to prohibit waiting at any time on the sides of road specified in Schedule 2 to this notice; and
- to restrict the waiting of vehicles between 8.30 a.m. and 6 p.m. on any day other than a Sunday on the side of the road specified in Schedule 3 to this notice, to 45 minutes in any 2 hours.

An exemption has been provided in (a) for Post Office vehicles and statutory undertakers.

The usual exemptions have been provided in (b) and (c) for disabled persons, statutory undertakers, local authority and water authority vehicles and for the loading and unloading of goods.

A copy of the Order and a copy of the 1975 Order, together with a plan and a statement of reasons for making the Order, may be seen during normal office hours at the offices of the Ceredigion District Council, Town Hall, Aberystwyth, during a period of 6 weeks from 26th April 1976.

Copies of the Order may be obtained, free of charge, on application to the Secretary of State, Welsh Office, Roads Department (Y Swyddfa Gymreig, Adran Ffyrdd), Graham Buildings, 139 Newport Road, Cardiff, CF2 1YU, quoting the reference WR15/2/20.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968, or that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within the aforesaid period of 6 weeks, apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained therein.

#### SCHEDULE 1

Sides of the Fishguard-Bangor (Menai Suspension Bridge) Trunk Road (A487) at Aberystwyth in the County of Dyfed:

- That length of the southern side of the trunk road known as North Parade which extends from its junctions with

Chalybeate Street to a point 8 yards north-east of that junction.

- That length of the southern side of the trunk road known as North Parade which extends from its junction with Terrace Road to a point 17 yards south-west of that junction.

#### SCHEDULE 2

That length of the northern side of the Fishguard-Bangor (Menai Suspension Bridge) Trunk Road (A487) at Aberystwyth in the County of Dyfed known as North Parade which extends from its junction with Baker Street in a general north-easterly direction to its junction with Terrace Road.

#### SCHEDULE 3

That length of the southern side of the Fishguard-Bangor (Menai Suspension Bridge) (Trunk Road (A487) at Aberystwyth in the County of Dyfed known as North Parade which extends from a point 8 yards north-east of Chalybeate Street in a general north-easterly direction to a point 17 yards south-west of its junction with Terrace Road.
