TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971

The Secretary of State for the Environment hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order under section 209 of the above Act to authorise the stopping up of length of Brenley Gardens, Kingsholm Gardens and Rancliffe Gardens, Eltham, S.E.9, to enable residential development to be carried out by Greenwich London Borough Council under Part III of the said Act.

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971

- (d) with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform.

The proposed Order will require improvements of Silverdale by widening.
