

2. The effect of the Order will be to consolidate without change in substance the Greenwich (Waiting and Loading Restriction) Order 1972 and the Orders which have amended that Order.

3. A copy of the Order, which will come into operation on 21st June 1976, and of the Greenwich (Waiting and Loading Restriction) Order 1972 (and of the Orders which have amended that Order) can be inspected during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays inclusive until the end of six weeks from the date on which the Order was made in Room B.21, The County Hall, London, SE1 7PB.

5. Any person desiring to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained therein on the ground that it is not within the powers of the relevant sections of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 or on the ground

that any requirement of those sections of the Act or of section 84A, 84B or 84C of the Act or of any regulations made under the said section 84C has not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within six weeks of the date on which the Order was made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.
