CUSTOMS AND EXCISE

NOTICE OF SEIZURE UNDER THE CUSTOMS AND EXCISE ACT 1952

Pursuant to section 275 (5) of the Customs and Excise Act 1952 and paragraph 1 of the 7th Schedule thereto, the Commissioners of Customs and Excise hereby give you notice that by virtue of the powers contained in the customs and excise Acts and enactments amending those Acts, certain goods, namely

One Mercedes Benz 300 SEL Motor Car, Registration number DO-Y-718

has been seized as liable to forfeiture upon the grounds that they, being chargeable with a duty of Customs were allowed to be imported without payment of that duty on condition that they would be exported from the United Kingdom not later than twelve months from the date of importation or from the date of your entry into the United Kingdom whichever is the earlier, and this condition was not complied with.

Whereby and by force of Article 17 (2) of the Customs Duty (Personal Relief) Order 1970 the said goods are liable to forfeiture.

If you claim that the said goods are not liable to forfeiture you must within one month from the date of this notice of seizure give notice of your claim in accordance with the said Schedule to the said Act specifying the name and address of a solicitor in the United Kingdom who is authorised to accept service of process and to act on your behalf. In default of such notice the said goods will be deemed to have been duly condemned as forfeited and will be liable to be disposed of in such manner as the

Commissioners of Customs and Excise may direct. If you make such claim within the time aforesaid, legal proceedings will be taken for the condemnation thereof.
