

The effect of the Order which comes into operation on 1st July 1976 will be to close the gap in the central reservation of that length of the trunk road known as Lower Street at its junction with Enderley Street.

Any person who desires to question the validity of, or of any provision contained in the Order on the ground that it is not within the powers with respect to the Order conferred by the above Act, or on the ground that any requirement of, or any instrument made under, any provision of that Act has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may within 6 weeks of 28th June 1976 apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained therein.

THE IMPORTED FOOD REGULATIONS 1968, AS AMENDED

Netherlands : Official Certificate

The Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food gives notice that in exercise of the powers conferred on him by the Imported Food Regulations 1968 (S.I. 1968 No. 97) as amended by the Imported Food (Amendment) Regulations 1973 (S.I. 1973 No. 1351) he hereby restricts recognition of (1) the Official Certificates reproduced in the Schedules to the notice published in the *London Gazette* dated 15th March 1938 and 19th January 1965 for the importation from the Netherlands of meat products and bacon and (2) the Official Certificate reproduced in the Schedule to the notice published in the *London Gazette* dated 24th August 1973 for the importation from the Netherlands of meat (including bacon), to the extent shown in the Schedule hereto.

The notice published in the *London Gazette* dated 6th April 1976 is hereby revoked.
