### TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971

The Secretary of State for the Environment hereby gives notice that on the application of the Lewisham London Borough Council, he proposes to make an Order under section 212 of the above Act to provide for the extinguishment of any right which persons may have to use vehicles on a length of the carriageway of Dartmouth Row, S.E.10.

The proposed Order will contain provisions for permitting the use of that highway by vehicles being used:
