Other changes in prize structure

- (iv) of the remainder, each complete £10,000 will be divided into:
 - 1 prize of £1,000 ;
 - 1 prize of £500 ;
 - 10 prizes of £100 ;
 - 100 prizes of £50 ;
 - 100 prizes of £25 ;
- (v) any amount of less than £10,000 will be allocated in prizes of £25, any residual sum of less than £25 being added to the prize fund in the following month.

The Fishguard—Bangor (Menai Suspension Bridge) Trunk Road (Pont Dolgefeiliu Diversion) Order 1976

The Fishguard—Bangor (Menai Suspension Bridge) Trunk Road (Pont Dolgefeiliu Diversion Side Roads) Order 1976.

The Secretary of State for Wales hereby gives notice that in relation to the above-mentioned Trunk Road at Pont Dolgefeiliu in the County of Gwynedd he has made under the Highways Act 1959

1. an Order under section 7 which provides:
 - (a) that a road which he proposes to construct at Pont Dolgefeiliu in the County of Gwynedd shall become a trunk road as from the date when the Order comes into operation, and
 - (b) that the length of the Fishguard—Bangor (Menai Suspension Bridge) Trunk Road to be superseded shall

cease to be a trunk road as from the date on which notice is given by him to the Gwynedd County Council that the new trunk road has been completed and is open for through traffic.

2. an Order under section 9 of the Highways Act 1959 authorising him

- (a) to improve, raise, lower or otherwise alter highways,
- (b) to stop up highways,
- (c) to construct new highways,
- (d) to stop up private means of access to premises, and
- (e) to provide new means of access to premises,

all at Pont Dolgefeiliu aforesaid and to provide the transfer of the said new highway to the County Council of Gwynedd as from the date on which he notifies the Council that the new highway has been completed and is open for through traffic.

Any person aggrieved by the Orders and desiring to question the validity thereof, or of any provision contained therein, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1959 or the Highways Act 1971 or on the ground that any requirement of either of those Acts, or of regulations made thereunder, has not been complied with in relation to the Orders, may within 6 weeks from 30th July 1976 apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Orders or of any provision contained therein.
