WATER RESOURCES ACT, 1963

NOTICE OF PROPOSALS FOR A LICENCE TO ABSTRACT WATER

Notice is hereby given that the South West Water Authority have in accordance with the Water Resources Act 1963

and the Water Resources (Licences) Regulations 1965 drafted a licence to abstract the following quantities of water from the River Tavy at N.G.R. SX 475650 (Lopwell Dam), viz.: 38,642 cubic metres (approximately 8,500,000 gallons) per day, with a total of 12,501,748 cubic metres (approximately 2,750 million gallons) per annum.

Further details of the proposals are that the licence shall remain in force from 1st April 1977 for a period of ten years and that it will provide that the flow in the River Tavy below Lopwell Dam shall not be reduced by virtue of the abstraction to below 40,920 cubic metres (approximately 9 million gallons) per day.

A copy of the draft licence and of the relevant plan may be inspected free of charge at the offices of the Authority at 3-5 Barnfield Road, Exeter, Devon, and at The Municipal Offices, Plymouth, Devon, at all reasonable times during the period beginning on 5th October 1976 and ending on 4th November 1976.

Any person who wishes to make representations about the proposals set out above should do so in writing to the Director of Administration, South West Water Authority, at 3-5 Barnfield Road, Exeter, EX1 1RE, before the end of the said period.

After the expiry of the period set for the inspection of the documents and the submission of representations the Authority will be entitled to pass a resolution by virtue of which a licence authorising the proposals shall be deemed to be granted, unless the Secretary of State for the Environment either in consequence of any representations made in respect of the proposals or otherwise, requires an application in respect of the proposals to be made to him.
