#### Y SWYDDFA GYMREIG HIGHWAYS ACTS 1959 TO 1971

*The Raglan—Llandoverly Trunk Road (Improvement between Cefn Brynich and Brynich Side Roads) Order 197*

The Secretary of State for Wales hereby gives notice that he proposes, in relation to the above mentioned Trunk

Road at Groesffordd Lane in the County of Powys, to make under section 9 of the Highways Act 1959 an Order which will:

- (a) authorise him:
  - (i) to improve, raise, lower or otherwise alter a highway;
  - (ii) to stop up a highway, and
  - (iii) to construct a new highway which will be a footpath,
 all at Groesffordd Lane aforesaid, and
- (b) provide for the transfer of the said new footpath to the County Council of Powys as from the date on which he notifies the Council that the new footpath has been completed and is open to pedestrians.
