The Trunk Road (Various Roads, Abergavenny) (One-Way Traffic and Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) (Variation) Order 197.

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State proposes to make an Order under sections 1 (1), (2), (3) and 84D of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1967. The effect of the Order will be to vary the Trunk Road (Various Roads, Abergavenny) (One-Way Traffic and Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1967 by extending the prohibited waiting on a section of the Raglan—Llandovery Trunk Road (A.40) by a distance of 11 yards. The prohibition will now apply as indicated in Schedule 1 to this notice. The limited waiting restrictions now in force on the trunk road will be reduced by a distance of 11 yards and the restriction will apply as indicated in Schedule 2 to this notice.

In addition to the normal exceptions to waiting in certain circumstances an exception will be provided in the Order for a disabled person's vehicle which displays in a relevant position both a disabled person's badge and a parking disc (on which the driver or other person in charge of the vehicle has marked the time at which the period of waiting began), on the side of road referred to in Schedule 1 to this notice, for a period not exceeding 2 hours (not being a period separated by an interval of less than 1 hour from a previous period of waiting by the same vehicle on the same side of road).

An exception will also be provided in the Order for a disabled person's vehicle which displays in the relevant position a disabled person's badge, to wait on the side of road specified in Schedule 2 to this notice.
