#### NEWCASTLE UPON TYNE CITY COUNCIL

##### *Newcastle upon Tyne City Council (Hutton Terrace) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1977*

Notice is hereby given that the City Council of Newcastle upon Tyne, as agents for the Tyne and Wear County Council, propose to make an Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972.
