##### NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF PUBLIC PATH ORDER

##### PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 1976

*Leicestershire County Council (Footpath No. D.7 (Part) and Footpath No. D.8 (Part) Houghton on the Hill)*

Notice is hereby given that the Leicestershire County Council has confirmed the above-named Order.

The effect of the Order, as confirmed, is to divert:

(i) that part of the public right of way, Footpath No. D.7, leading from the north of Houghton Lodge to Main Street, Houghton-on-the-Hill, which extends from a point at its junction with Stretton Lane in a generally east-north-easterly direction through O.P. No. 4817 for a total distance of 156 yards to a point approximately 30 yards south-west of Main Street; to a line which extends from the point at the junction with Stretton Lane previously described in a generally north-easterly direction to a point on the new school boundary fence, thence continuing along that fence in an easterly then south-easterly direction to re-join the existing footpath D.7 at the point approximately 30 yards south-west of Main Street previously described;

(ii) that part of the public right of way, Footpath No. D.8, leading from Stretton Lane to the Houghton-on-the-Hill Primary School, which extends from a point on the southern boundary of O.P. No. 4817, approximately 51 yards from the south-west corner of that parcel, in a north-easterly direction to the new school boundary fence, thence following the fence in north-westerly, north-easterly and north-westerly directions to its junction with the original route of footpath D.7; to a line which extends from the point on the southern boundary of O.P. No. 4817 previously described in a north-north easterly direction through that parcel for a distance of 183 yards to its junction with the proposed alternative route of footpath D.7 at the new school boundary fence.

The Order becomes operative as from the date of confirmation, but if any person aggrieved by the Order desires to question the validity thereof or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1959, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or any regulations made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the con-

firmation of the Order, he may, within 6 weeks from the date of this notice make application for the purpose to the High Court.
