

17. Providing for the demolition of the redundant parish church of the former parish of Saint Mark, Edge-lane, Liverpool, in the diocese of Liverpool, and empowering the said Commissioners to sell or lease its site and the land annexed or belonging thereto.

18. Providing for the demolition of the redundant former parish church of Christ Church, Hougham-in-Dover, in the diocese of Canterbury, and empowering the said Commissioners to sell its site and the land annexed or belonging thereto.

19. Providing for the appropriation of the redundant parish church of the former parish of Christ Church, Luton, in the diocese of Saint Albans, to use for cultural, educational and social purposes and the appropriation of the land annexed or belonging thereto to use for purposes ancillary to the use of the redundant building and for a public open space, and empowering Saint Albans Diocesan Board of Finance to lease the building and land for the said uses.

20. Uniting the parishes of Thelveton and Frenze, in the diocese of Norwich, and declaring redundant the parish church of the parish of Frenze.

21. Uniting the benefices and parishes of Saint David, West Holloway; and Saint Clement, Barnsbury, in the diocese of London, and declaring redundant the parish church of the parish of Saint Clement, Barnsbury.

22. Uniting the benefices and parishes of Saint Andrew, Surbiton, and Saint Mark, Surbiton, in the diocese of Southwark.

23. Uniting the benefices of Cratfield with Heveningham and Ubbeston; and Huntingfield with Cookley, in the diocese of Saint Edmundsbury and Ipswich.
