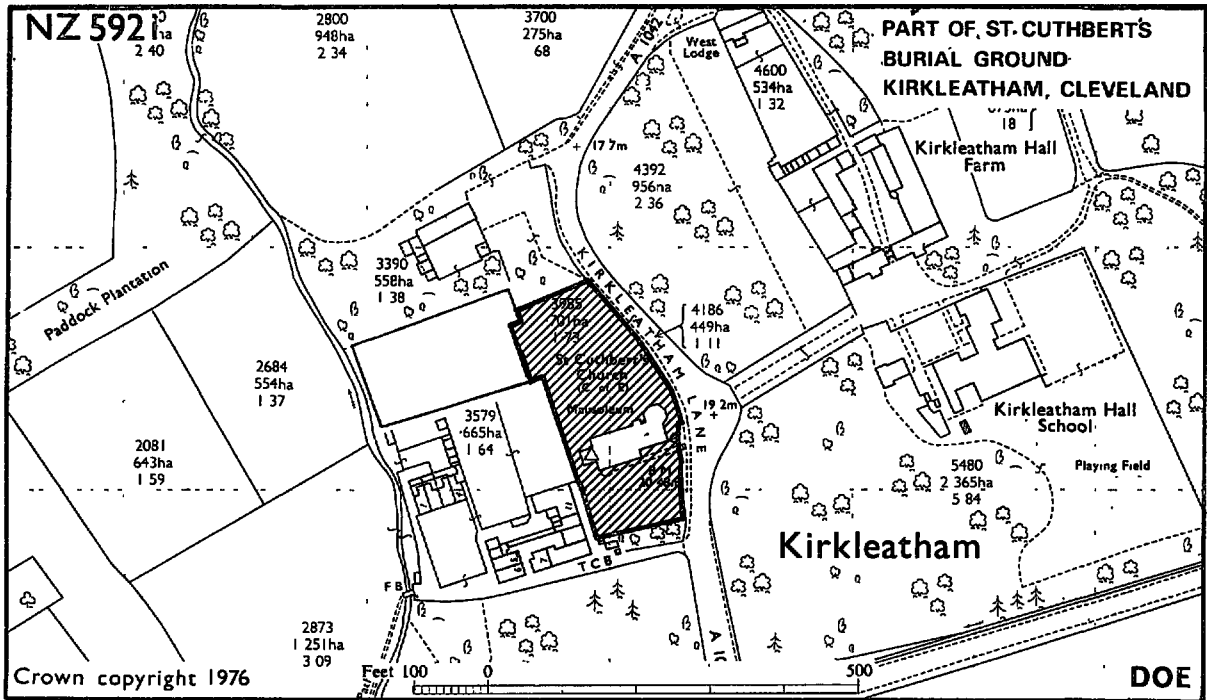


The Plan referred to in the foregoing Order in Council

The Trunk Road (Gilwern, Gwent) (Prohibition of Right-Hand Turn) Order 1977

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for Wales proposes to make an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle proceeding in a general westerly direction on the length of road specified in the Schedule to this notice from making a right-hand turn into the classified road A.4077 known as Main Road, Gilwern.

A copy of the proposed Order, together with a plan and a statement of reasons for making the Order, may be seen during normal office hours at the offices of the Gwent County Council, Highways Department (Northern Division), Llanfoist, Abergavenny.

Objections to the proposed Order should be sent to the Secretary of State, Welsh Office (Y Swyddfa Gymreig), Government Buildings, Ty Glas Road, Llanishen, Cardiff, CF4 5PL, by the 17th March 1977, quoting the reference WR15/3/29, and stating the grounds of objection.

That length of the Neath—Abergavenny Trunk Road (A.465) Heads of the Valleys Road which joins with the classified road A.4077 known as Main Road at Gilwern in the County of Gwent.

Town and Country Planning Act 1971

The Secretary of State for Wales hereby gives notice that he proposes, on the application of the Taff-Ely Borough Council to make an Order under section 212 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971 for extinguishing any rights which persons may have to use vehicles on the highway specified in the Schedule to this notice.

SCHEDULE

The highway is situated at Llantrisant in the Borough of Taff-Ely in the County of Mid Glamorgan and is an irregular shaped length of the area known as the Bull Ring extending from its junction with High Street in a general westerly direction for a distance of approximately 29 yards.
