NORTH YORKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

The Council of the County of North Yorkshire (South Street, Gargrave) (Limited Restriction of Waiting) Order 1977.

Notice is hereby given that on 18th February 1977 the Council of the County of North Yorkshire in exercise of their powers under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972, have made an Order, the effect of which is to limit the waiting of vehicles to twenty minutes in any hour on the south side of South Street, Gargrave, from a point 42 metres east of its junction with Church Street for a distance of 20 metres in an easterly direction.

A copy of the Order which will come into operation on 8th March 1977, together with a map showing the length of road concerned, may be examined at the Area Highways Office, Croft House, Carleton Road, Skipton, and at County Hall, Northallerton, during normal office hours.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regula-

tion Act 1967, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order you may within 6 weeks from 18th February 1977 apply to the High Court for this purpose.
