TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order under section 209 of the above Act to authorise the stopping up of that part of Highway VD 10, Kettering, starting from its junction with St. John's Road, about 65 yards to the east of Churchill Way, and extending in a northerly direction for about 133 yards, to enable residential development to be carried out in accordance with planning permission granted to Jelson (Estates) Limited.

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that on the application of the York District Council, he proposes to make an Order under section 212 of the above Act to provide for the extinguishment of any right which persons may have to use vehicles on lengths of Thief Lane, Norman Street and Lamel Street in the district of York.

The proposed Order will contain provisions for permitting the use of those highways by vehicles being used:
