EAST DEVON DISTRICT COUNCIL
 TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT, 1971

Conservation Areas at Sidmouth in the County of Devon

Notice is hereby given that in pursuance of section 277 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971, as amended by section 1 of the Town and Country Amenities Act 1974, that the East Devon District Council following consultation with the Devon County Council have agreed that the areas described in the Schedule to this notice are areas of special architectural and historic interest, the character or appearance of which it is desirable to preserve or enhance and have therefore designated the said areas as Conservation Areas. In two cases, extensions have been made to existing Conservation Areas.

The effect of the designation of these Conservation Areas is that where an application for planning permission for the development of land in or adjacent to a conservation area is made to the Council, which would in the opinion of the Council, affect the character or appearance of the conservation area, the application will be subject to the special procedures contained in sections 28, 29, 31 and 277A of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971.

A map of these Conservation Areas may be inspected during normal office hours at the offices of the Council at 31 Southernhay East, Exeter or the Council Offices, Knowle, Sidmouth, Devon.

SCHEDULE

Sidmouth Conservation Areas

1. *Elysian Fields Conservation Area*
 The Conservation Area includes 2-26 (even), 15 and 23 Temple Street together with The Hermitage, Moons Green and The Shrubbery. 1 to 4 (inclusive) Fairlawn Court and all the properties and their grounds in Elysian Fields are included together with the property on the south side of Sidmount Gardens and Sidmount, Claremont, and Claremont Cottage to the east of Station Road.
2. *Sidford Conservation Area*
 The boundary of the Conservation Area runs around the rear gardens of the properties fronting School Street from Sidford Cross to Country House (and including 5 Brook Lane) on the west and to Sidford Farm House on the east. 143 and 145 Sidford Road and all properties and their gardens on the north side of Church Street are included as they are on the south side from the public toilets to Pack Horse Bridge (with the exclusion of Rivermead).
3. *Salcombe Regis Conservation Area*
 The Conservation Area includes the whole of the Village from Salcombe Regis Thorn to the north to Springcombe at the southern boundary and from the eastern boundary of O.S. Field 9691 to include O.S. Fields 7794, 7887 and 7377 in the west.
4. *Extensions to the Sidmouth Town Conservation Area*
 - (a) The Conservation Area has been extended to include all the properties and their grounds on Salcombe Road and on the north side of All Saints Road (but excluding the Vicarage) together with Sidlands Lodge and the Conservative Club in Radway and Radway Lodge, 1 and 2 Enfield and 1-6 (inclusive) in Vicarage Road.
 - (b) The Conservation Area has been extended to the west to include the following properties and their grounds: Belmont Hotel, Victoria Hotel and the Royal Glen together with the Glen Goyle Pleasure Ground.
 - (c) To the east of the Conservation Area has been extended to include all the properties in Milford Avenue and Milford Road (with the exception of Rivermead) together with Salcombe Hill House Hotel in Beatlands Road.
5. *Extensions to the Sidbury Conservation Area*
 The following extensions have been made to the Conservation Area:
 - (a) To include all the properties fronting Fore Street and southwards along the rear of properties fronting Chapel Street to include 1-5 Chapel Street to the south of Pound Field on the east and the field immediately south of the Congregational Church on the west. Properties in Greenhead from its junction with Fore Street as far as and including 4 Greenhead on the north side and the private garage on the south side are also included.
 - (b) Along Bridge Street from the Mill Race to include 1, 2 and 3 Riverside Deepway.
 - (c) To include Manor Cottage and the adjoining properties to the south in Ridgeway Lane.

Notice is hereby given that Elmbridge Borough Council, in pursuance of section 277 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971, as amended by section 1 of the Town and Country Amenities Act 1974, has designated as a Conservation Area the area described below:

An area around Weston Green encompassing, on the west side of Hampton Court Way, the land and properties from the Lamb and Star Public House to the north, to The Lodge to the south and in a westerly direction to include Marney's Pond, All Saints' Church, Jubilee Villas, The Alma Arms Public House, the cottages in Alma Road and Nos. 6-18 Chestnut Avenue; and on the east side of Hampton Court Way an area bounded by the properties
