TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971

SCHEDULE

(The distances are approximate)

The lengths of highway to be stopped up are in the Borough of Newport in the County of Gwent. They are shown by heavy black edging on the deposited plan and are those areas of Upper Dock Street which comprise:

- (i) part of a circular area 6½ yards in diameter, the centre of which is situated 36 yards south-east of the junction of Upper Dock Street and Corn Street, and 2 yards west of the eastern side of Upper Dock Street;
- (ii) a triangular area, the base of which is situated on that part of the eastern side of Upper Dock Street which extends from a point 53½ yards south-east of the junction of Upper Dock Street and Corn Street to a point 62½ yards south-east of the said junction, and the apex of which is situated 54 yards south-east of the said junction and 3 yards west of the eastern side of Upper Dock Street; and
- (iii) a triangular area, the base of which is situated on that part of the eastern side of Upper Dock Street which extends from a point 65½ yards south-east of the junction of Upper Dock Street and Corn Street to a point 72½ yards south-east of the said junction, and the apex of which is situated 66 yards south-east of the said junction and 3 yards west of the eastern side of Upper Dock Street.

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971

The highway is at Newport in the County of Gwent. It is shown by zebra hatching on the deposited plan and is part of that length of highway known as Upper Dock Street which extends from its junction with Austin Friars, an approximate distance of 97 yards.

SCHEDULE 2

Cases where vehicles are permitted to use the highway described in Schedule 1 to this Order

Where the vehicle is a vehicle of any description and is using the highway:

- (a) for police, ambulance or fire brigade purposes;
