ROAD TRAFFIC ACTS

HARTLEPOOL BOROUGH COUNCIL

Hartlepool Borough Council (Fens Shopping Centre Car Park) (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 1977

The Hartlepool Borough Council made the above mentioned Order on the 23rd May, 1977 under the provisions of Sections 31(1) and 84D(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967. The Order will come into operation on the 30th May, 1977.

The effect of the Order will be to control the use of the parking places set out within Hartlepool known as the Fens Shopping Centre Car Park. The Schedule to this Notice sets out the details of the classes of vehicle which may use the car park, the days and times of operation and the maximum period of waiting applicable to the car park.

The Order specifies the conditions under which the parking places may be used. Full details are contained in the Order, which, together with a map showing the location of the Parking Places, may be seen at the Civic Centre, Victoria Road, Hartlepool, Monday to Friday between the hours of 9 a.m. and 4.30 p.m.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provisions contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part 9 of the Transport Act 1968, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within 6 weeks from the 23rd May, 1977, apply to the High Court for this purpose.

TAMWORTH BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Borough of Tamworth (Off-Street Parking Places—Tamworth) Order 1977

Notice is hereby given that on 23rd May 1977 Tamworth Borough Council made the above-named Order under Section 31(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972.

The effect of this Order which comes into operation on the 30th May 1977 is to control the parking places named in the Schedule to this Notice, which shows the class of vehicles, the days and times of operation, the maximum period of waiting for each parking place and the scale of charges for parking tickets. The Order also imposes a Standard Charge (i.e. the charge made for non-purchase of ticket) of £6.00.

A copy of the Order and a map showing the location of the parking places is on deposit at the Municipal Offices, Church Street, Tamworth, where they may be examined during normal office hours.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may within 6 weeks from the 23rd May 1977, apply to the High Court for this purpose.
