## HIGHWAYS ACTS 1959 TO 1971

## The M4 Motorway (Castleton to Coryton Section) and Connecting Roads Scheme (Side Roads) (No. 2) Order 1977

## The M4 Motorway (Castleton to Coryton Section) and Connecting Roads Scheme (Side Roads) (Variation) Order 1977

The Secretary of State for Wales hereby gives notice that, in relation to the part of the M4 Motorway which will be situated between Castleton in the County of Gwent and Coryton in the County of South Glamorgan, he has made:

1. An Order under section 13 of the Highways Act 1959 the effect of which is—

(a) to authorise him:

(i) to improve, raise, lower or otherwise alter highways;

(ii) to stop up highways;

(iii) to construct new highways;

(iv) to stop up private means of access to premises; and

(v) to provide new means of access to premises all on or in the vicinity of the route of the above-mentioned part of the said Motorway, and

(b) to provide for the transfer of each of the said new highways to the highway authority specified therefor in the Order as from the date on which he notifies that authority that the new highway is open for through traffic.

2. An Order under sections 13, 18 and 286 of the Highways Act 1959, section 27 of the Local Government Act 1966 and section 62 of the Highways Act 1971 which will authorise him to vary the powers conferred by the M4 Motorway (Castleton to Coryton Section) and Connecting Roads Scheme (Side Roads) Order 1975, hereinafter referred to as "the 1975 Order", and enable him:

(a) to stop up Cherry Orchard Road, Lisvane, for about 84 metres south-eastwards from a point about 10 metres south-east of its junction with Footpath No. 5 (Lisvane PH), to omit the power to improve that same length of Cherry Orchard Road from the 1975 Order, and to provide new private means of access from the properties known as Cherry Orchard Cottage, Haul Fryn, Felindre Fach and Bryncoed over part of the stopped-up length of Cherry Orchard Road to the new length of highway referred to as letter 'B' in Schedule 3 to the 1975 Order;

(b) to stop up Footpath No. 5 (Lisvane PH) for about 28 metres south-westwards from its junction with Cherry Orchard Road;

(c) to extend the new private means of access to British Rail land near Wern Fawr, provided for in the 1975 Order, at its southern point, to enable the new private means of access to extend from the pedestrian access
