Notice is hereby given that the Blaenau Gwent Borough Council propose to make the above-named Order acting on behalf of the Gwent County Council in pursuance of

arrangements made under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 and in exercise of the Gwent County Council's powers under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 of the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974.

When this Order comes into effect it will not be permissible for vehicles to enter or leave Bailey Street, Brynmawr, at the junction with the road leading to Lower Bailey Street.

**BLAENAU GWENT BOROUGH COUNCIL**

*Borough of Blaenau Gwent (Various Streets, Ebbw Vale) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1977*

Notice is hereby given that the Blaenau Gwent Borough Council propose to make the above-named Order acting on behalf of the Gwent County Council in pursuance of arrangements made under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 and in exercise of the Gwent County Council's powers under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 of the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974.

When these Orders come into effect vehicles may not wait at any time in the lengths or on the sides of roads specified in the Schedule hereto.

Exceptions will be included in the Order to permit waiting for the purposes of:

- (a) picking up and setting down passengers;
- (b) loading or unloading goods;
- (c) delivery or collection of postal packets;
- (d) the maintenance of the road;
- (e) the supply of gas, water and electricity and of any telegraphic line;
- (f) the pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
- (g) a funeral, and
- (h) exempting vehicles of disabled persons.

The draft Orders, maps showing the affected lengths of road and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order may be examined at Room 38 at the Town Clerk's Department, Municipal Offices, Civic Centre, Ebbw Vale, Gwent, during normal office hours.

**SCHEDULE**

*Newchurch Road, Ebbw Vale*

(a) south side, from the northern kerbline of Beaufort Road in an easterly direction for a distance of 120 metres;
(b) west side, from the northern end of the existing restriction in a northerly direction for a distance of 70 metres.

*Access Road to Printing Works, Ebbw Vale*

Both sides, from the southern kerbline of the access road to Queens Square in a southerly direction for a distance of 45 metres.

*Access Road to Queens Square, Ebbw Vale*

Both sides, for a distance of 10 metres in a south-easterly direction from the eastern kerbline of the Access Road to Printing Works.

*Queensway, Garnlydan, Ebbw Vale*

From the eastern boundary of No. 83 Queensway in a southerly direction to the eastern boundary of No. 53 Queensway.
