 - (iv) to prohibit vehicles waiting for the purposes of delivering or collecting goods or merchandise or loading and unloading between the hours of 8 a.m. and 9.30 a.m. and between the hours of 4.30 p.m. and 6 p.m. Monday to Saturday inclusive in the roads or lengths of road specified in Part I of Schedule 3 to this notice;
 - (v) to prohibit vehicles waiting for the purposes of delivering or collecting goods or merchandise or loading and unloading at any time on any day on the length of road specified in Part II of Schedule 3 to this notice;
 - (vi) to prohibit the driving of vehicles in the roads or lengths of road specified in Column 1 of Schedule 4 to this notice other than in the direction specified in Column 2 of the said Schedule;
 - (vii) to authorise the use of each of the parts of the road specified in Column 2 of Schedule 5 to this notice as places for bicycles propelled by mechanical powers and not having a sidecar attached.

Exceptions have been provided in the proposed Order in so far as it relates to the restriction and prohibition of waiting for the purposes of, interalia, boarding or alighting, loading and unloading (except at any time in the road specified in Part II of Schedule 3 to this notice and between the hours specified in paragraph (iv) to this notice in the roads specified in Part I of Schedule 3 to this notice), building and road works, maintenance of essential services and the delivery or collection of postal packets by vehicles in the service of the Post Office. The usual exceptions for disabled person's vehicles are also included in the proposed Order.
